

Summary of Bylaw Changes Related to the Trust Fund Committee

29 November 2016

1. Reduce the elected membership from six to five.
2. Clarify that the Congregation Council will fill any vacancies until there can be an election at the next congregational meeting.
3. Remove the congregational treasurer from the Committee and allow the Trust Fund Committee to annually appoint a non-voting treasurer.
4. The Pastor and Council President shall continue to be ex officio members but they will be non-voting.

- C13.06.02 A *Trust Fund Committee* of ~~six~~ five voting members shall be elected by this congregation at the annual meeting. Term of office shall be three years with no more than two members elected to full terms each year. Members shall not be eligible to serve more than four consecutive terms.
- a. Vacancies on the Trust Fund Committee shall be filled by temporary appointment of the Congregation Council with election to occur at the next congregational meeting.
 - b. The congregation treasurer shall be an ex officio member of the committee. The Trust Fund Committee shall annually appoint a treasurer who will serve as a non-voting member of the committee.
 - c. Notwithstanding C13.08, the pastor and president of this congregation shall serve as non-voting ex officio members of the Trust Fund Committee.
